Summary of Discussion	The following comments are from Ana Casareto regarding the proposed updates to the ANTH 213 course outline:  Course title: From: Introduction to the Indians of Great Basin To: Introduction to the Indigenous Peoples of the Great Basin The use of the word "Indians" is outdated and represents a colonial through mid/late 20th century history of oppression and racism towards long established native populations. Although current anthropological literature uses the terms Indigenous and Native Americans interchangeably, I chose to use the term "Indigenous" to match the nomenclature found in the Native 1st Scholarship Program literature.  Student Learning Outcomes: The wording was outdated with unassessable outcomes, so we changed them to measurable items. We also linked course objectives to GE ISLO requirements.
