	These options help us meet students where they are by accommodating their schedules and work and personal responsibilities.
	Flexible learning includes: courses that are shorter than the traditional 16-week semester, self-paced courses,

instructor-defined paced courses, competency based, guided self-paced.

Next steps: identifying existing courses that fit these models, training faculty in designing courses in these models, design a webpage to provide information on this model and degree pathways that can be completed in this model.

How will students/advisors know that a class is being offered in a flexible model?

- it will be an "8000" class, and there will be further information in the class notes

- there is a plan being developed with IR to pull overall success data
