DLC will send out a rationale to faculty on why this is an appropriate rubric which is standardized and used across multiple colleges and universities. DLC will also create a one-page rationale. Justin and Patrick will work on the rationale. Justin will work on the survey that will be sent out to faculty. Address fears of faculty of academic freedom (i.e., the document will be prescriptive rather than flexible). Our goal is to communicate that the rubric enhances the quality of online learning environment and is not restrictive of academic freedom. Once complete will be sent to the DLC, to academic faculty (survey), then to faculty senate.
