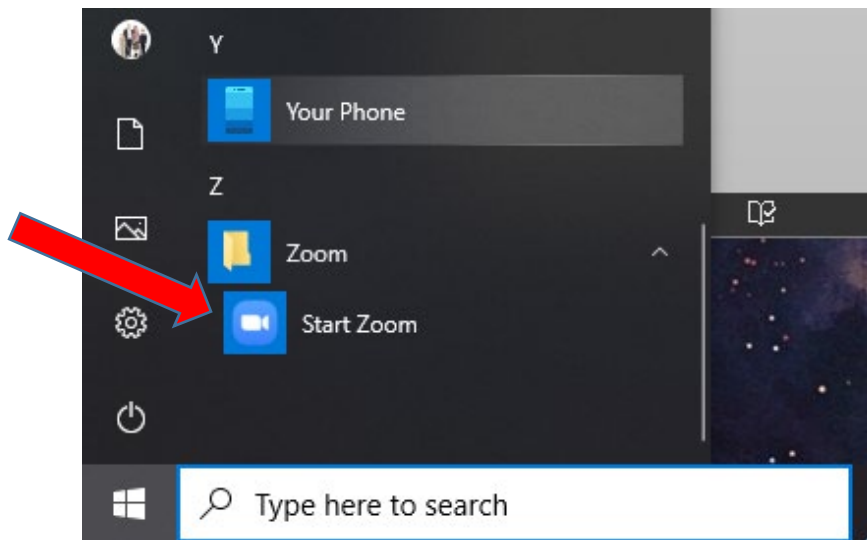
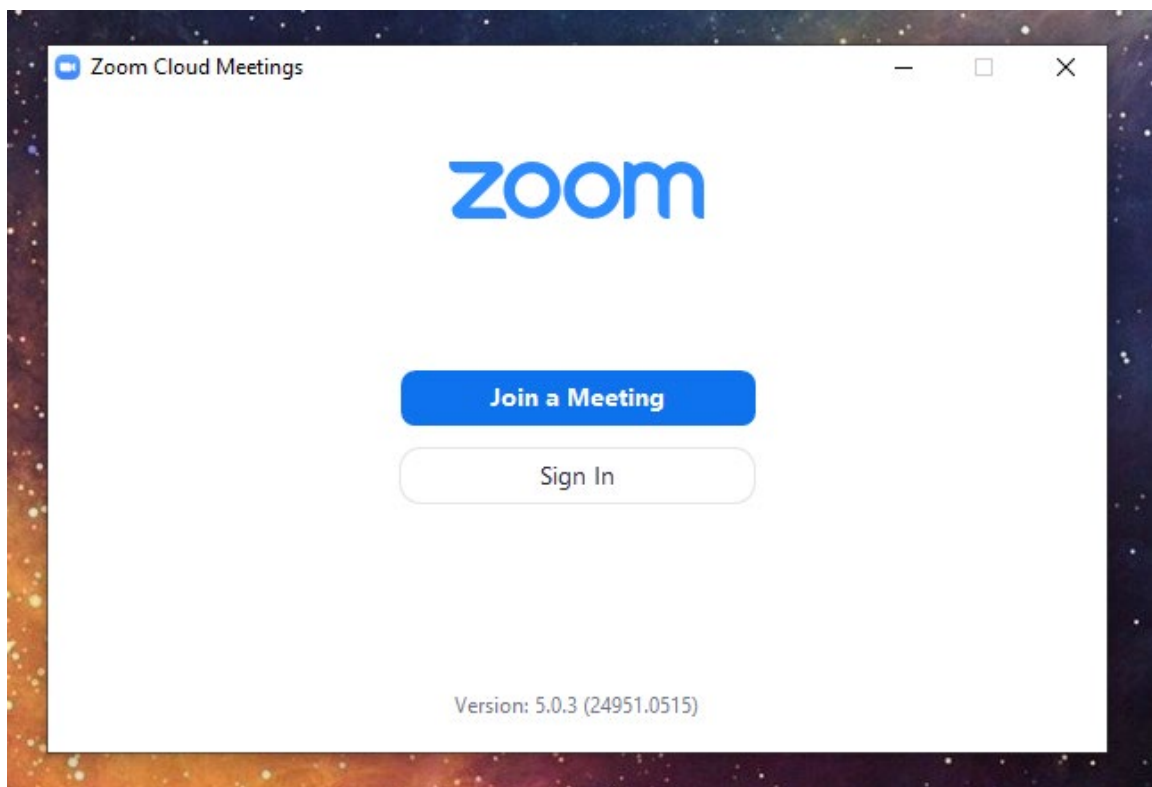


Zoom Login Instructions

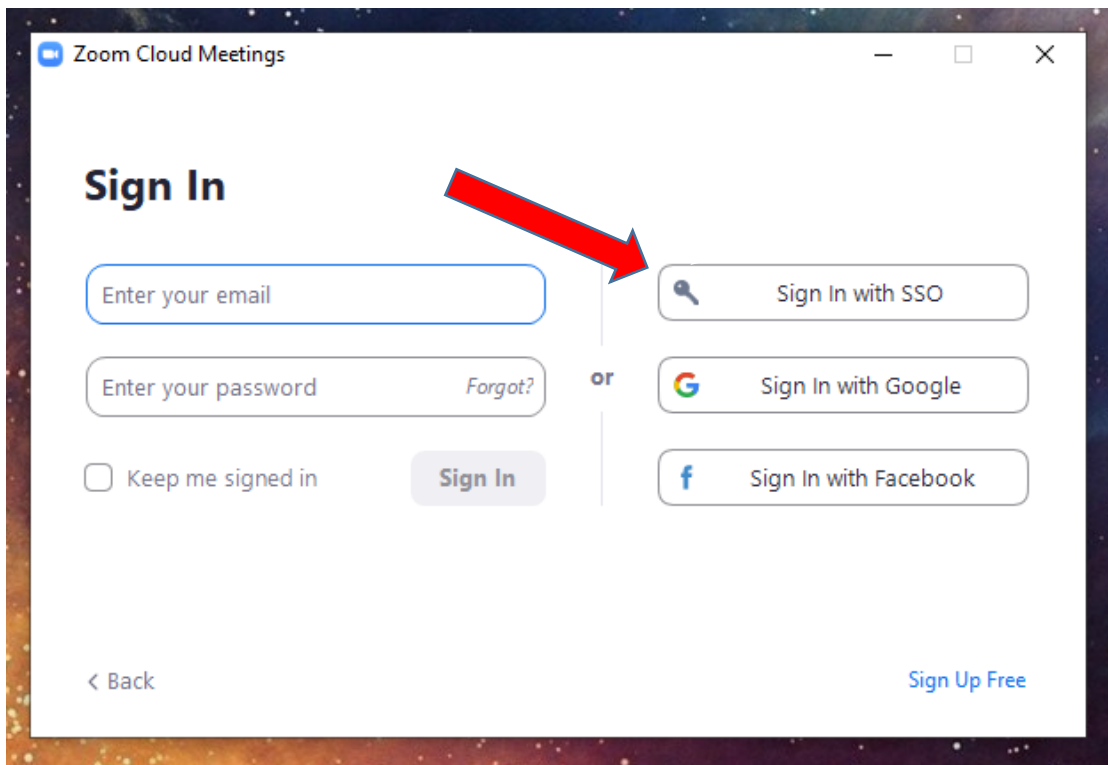
1. Launch the Zoom application
 - a) Click the Windows button in the bottom left corner of the desktop
 - b) Scroll down the list of applications until you find the Zoom application and left click it



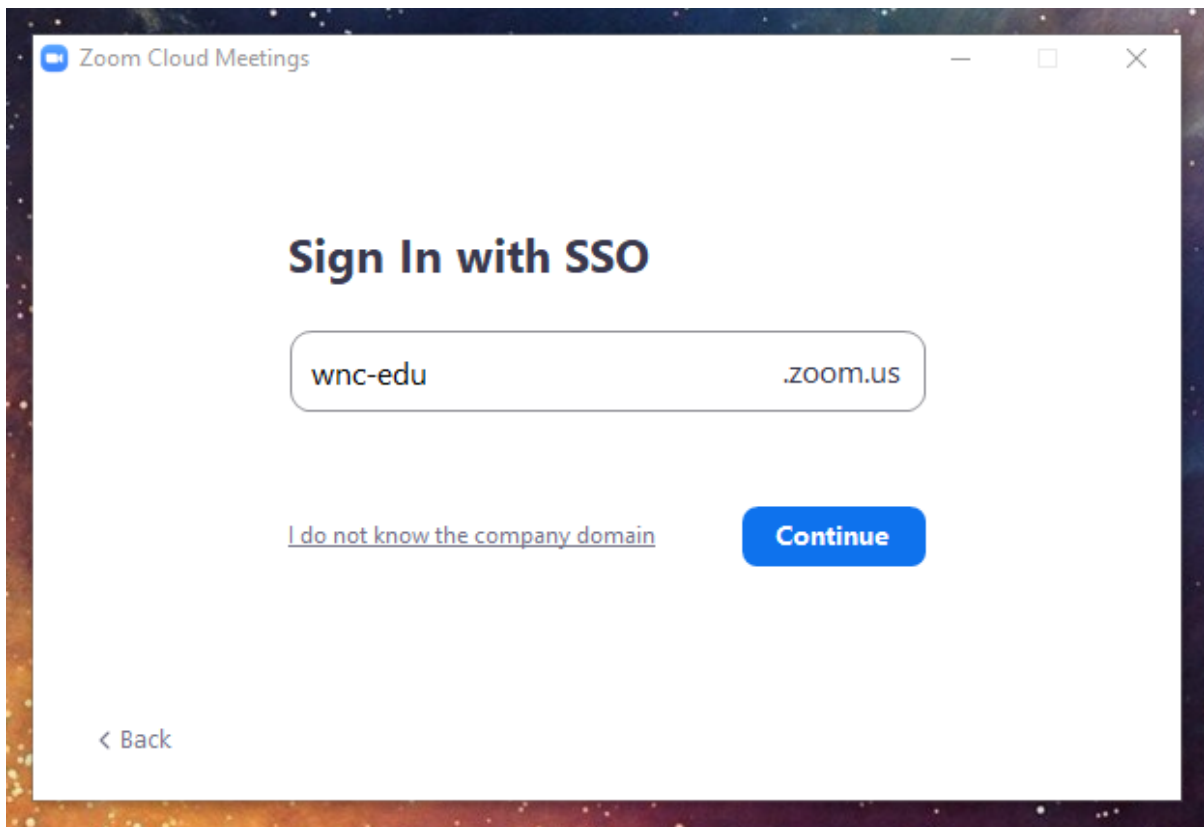
2. Click the "Sign In" button



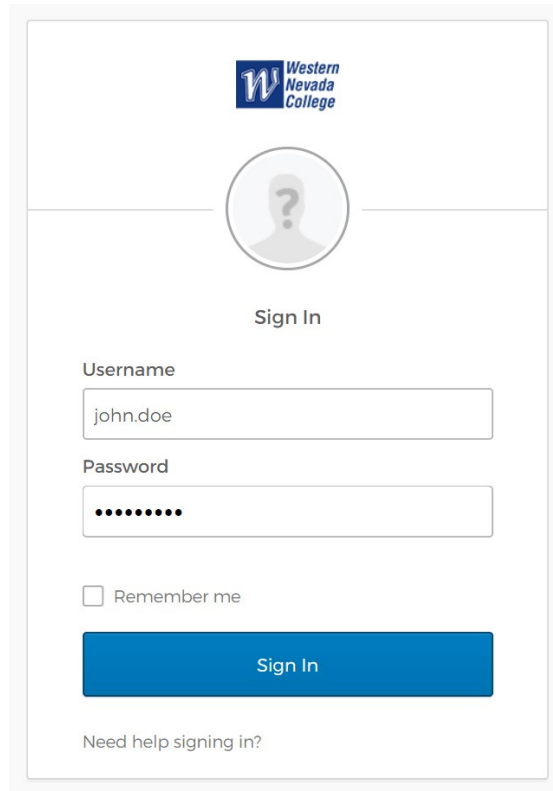
3. Click the "Sign In with SSO" button



4. Enter the company domain which is "wnc-edu" and then click "Continue"

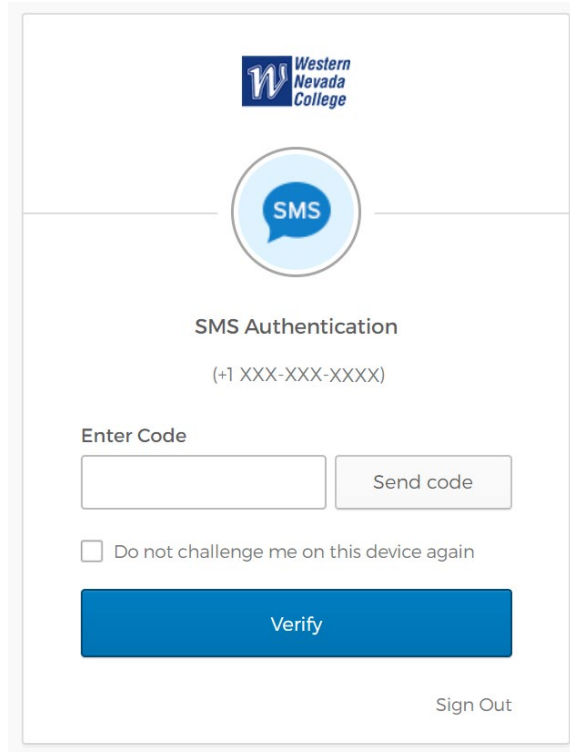


5. You should now see an Okta login page with the Western Nevada College logo. Enter your WNC Anywhere login information which is the login you use when you log in to your computers on campus. Your username should be your firstname.lastname. After you enter your username and password, click “Sign In”.



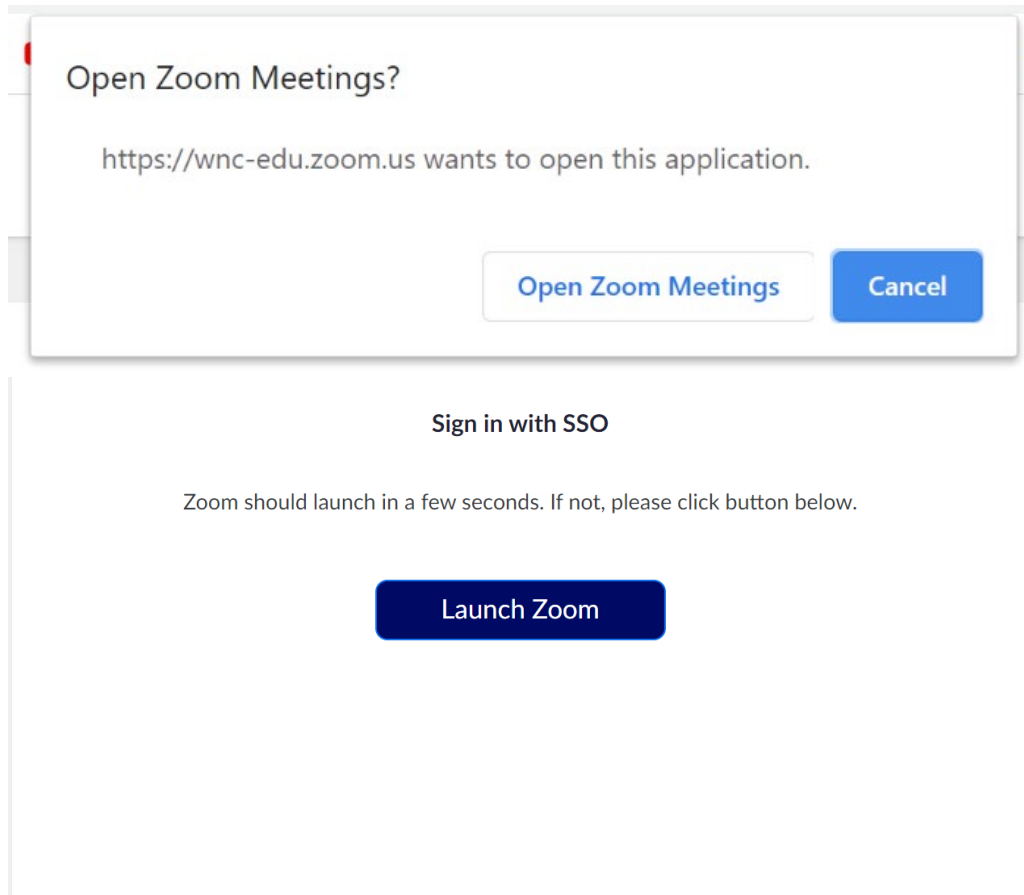
