2023-24 Workforce, Career, and Technical Education and Liberal Arts and Sciences Student Learning Outcomes Assessment Report Summary September 2024

This report summarizes Workforce, Career, and Technical Education (WCTE) and Liberal Arts (LA) Course-Level Student Learning Outcome (SLO) Assessment Reports submitted for the 2023-24 academic year. It is divided into the following sections:

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Introduction: Student Learning Outcomes and Reporting Process Overview

The following WNC institutional SLOs guide all courses, programs, and degrees offered by WNC. SLOs 1-6 provide the structure for general education and alignment for academic program outcomes, while SLO 7 provides a connection for career preparation emphases.

For the 2023-24 academic year, the JotForm platform was again used for creating and submitting course-level SLO reports. In these reports, academic faculty identify key assignments, projects, or tasks that serve as indicators to assess a course-level SLO, which is mapped to an institutional SLO identified in the report. Student performance on indicators was measured by evaluating whether students achieved the **Threshold** or **Target** for a given indicator:

- Threshold: At least 50% of students achieve 70% on assessment
- Target: At least 70% of students achieve 70% on assessment

In addition, academic faculty are asked to identify how they will use these assessment results moving forward, and are asked to provide updates on past assessment project result implementation.

Each year, LA and WCTE faculty are asked to include SLO assessment projects as part of their annual plans. These annual plans are submitted to academic directors at the start of the academic year, and always require the inclusion of an assessment project. Typically, faculty conduct assessments during the fall semester and report on results in the following spring. Some faculty conduct multiple assessment projects across multiple semesters as well, and some faculty choose to additionally conduct non-SLO assessment projects. This report summarizes the SLO assessments that were completed and reported to the IRE office by September 2024.

Section 1: Summary of SLO Course Assessments for 2023-24

The following tables summarize course-level SLO assessment results from LA and WCTE for the 2023-24 academic year. Twenty-four courses completed a total of 49 assessment reports in LA, and 4 courses completed a total of 7 assessment reports in WCTE.

Notes on Sec. 1: Summary of SLO Course Assessments for 2023-24

Liberal Arts faculty submitted a significantly higher number of reports as compared to the prior year, with 24 courses submitting 49 reports (as compared with 26 courses submitting 38 reports for 2022-23). WCTE continues to have low levels of reported assessment completion, with 5 classes submitting 5 reports for 2022-23. This is similar to the prior 2022-23 year, which had 5 courses submitting 5 assessment reports.

Section 2: Recommendations for Future Course Assessment Reports

Updates on Previous Recommendations from 2022-23 Report

Increase participation in assessment reporting, curriculum mapping, and the review of
assessment results at the program level. This year showed a significant increase in the number
of reports submitted in the Liberal Arts and Sciences division, though there continue to be low
levels of assessment reporting in the Workforce, Career, and Technical Education division.
Nursing and Allied Health continues to focus assessment efforts on ACEN professional
accreditation requirements for its AAS Nursing program.

The creation of the Accreditation and Curriculum Management Coordinator position, with time dedicated to supporting assessment, has created some needed energy around assessment. Course outlines are being updated by faculty, helping to familiarize teaching faculty with the stated course objectives and generating conversations around how achievement of objectives are measured. Additionally, a new approach to program review will provide further opportunities to review curriculum and determine how best to use assessment data in determining the efficacy of program curriculum.

Recommendations for the Upcoming 2023-24 Year

• Increase participation in assessment reporting, curriculum mapping, and the review of assessment results at the program level. In particular, it is clear that WCTE faculty need additional support around assessment, including in the creation of assessment plans and the reporting of assessment results. Nursing and Allied Health should also begin regular SLO assessments for its degree-granting programs not currently included in its assessment work for the AAS Nursing program. Liberal Arts should consider strategies to increase assessment participation from faculty and disciplines that have been underrepresented in assessment reporting, as well as strategies to ensure the assessment of all SLOs.
