Mission Fulfillment Executive Summary

Western Nevada College (WNC) is a comprehensive community college based in Carson City, NV, that serves nearly 5,000 students each year across a five-county service area of more than 8,000 square miles. WNC is one of eight member institutions under the Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE), which operates under the authority of the Nevada Constitution. WNC's mission, along with our full 2019-2025 Strategic Plan, was approved by the NSHE Board of Regents in March 2019.

- **Mission Statement:** WNC contributes to solutions for the 21st century by providing effective educational pathways for the students and communities of Nevada.
- **Vision Statement:** WNC is an integral and innovative educational partner fostering equity and a life of learning in an inclusive environment for the evolving, diverse communities we serve.
- **Values Statement:** WNC is student centered, inquiry driven, and data informed as we nurture community connections and promote an environment of equity and inclusion.

Our mission statement focuses on the diverse and meaningful educational pathways that we provide for our students and communities. These pathways include transfer degrees for students continuing their education at the university level, professional degrees and certificates designed to match the workforce skills needed for today's Nevada, and a wide range of continuing educational opportunities for personal enrichment and professional development. Our mission is actively guided by our values, and the development and expansion of our educational pathways is informed by the aspirations in our vision.

WNC’s 2019-2025 Strategic Plan established our educational pathways of Transfer Education, Professional Education, and Lifelong Learning as our core themes. Our objectives align to NSHE’s objectives of Access, Success, Close the Achievement Gap, and Workforce.

WNC assesses mission fulfillment by reviewing a collection of key performance indicators (KPIs) identified in our 2019-2025 Strategic Plan and reported to the NSHE Board of Regents in an annual metrics report. Mission fulfillment is defined as meeting 80% of the thresholds for the following KPIs.

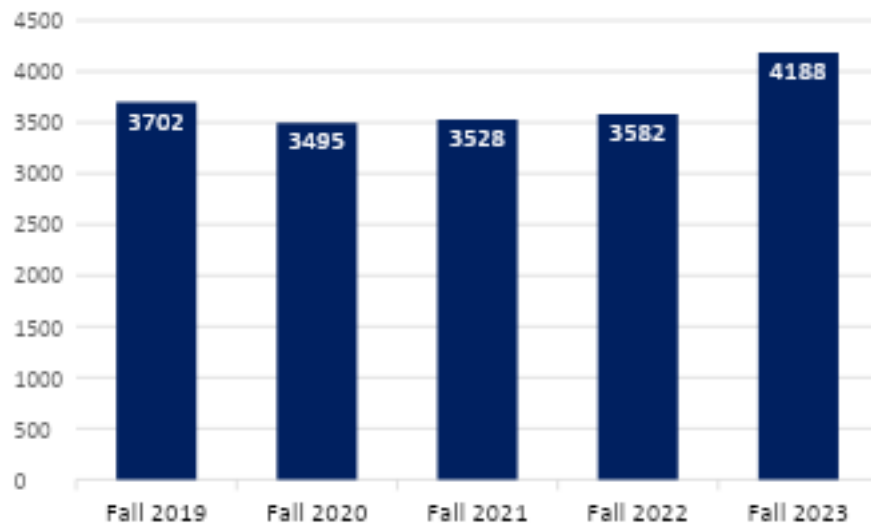

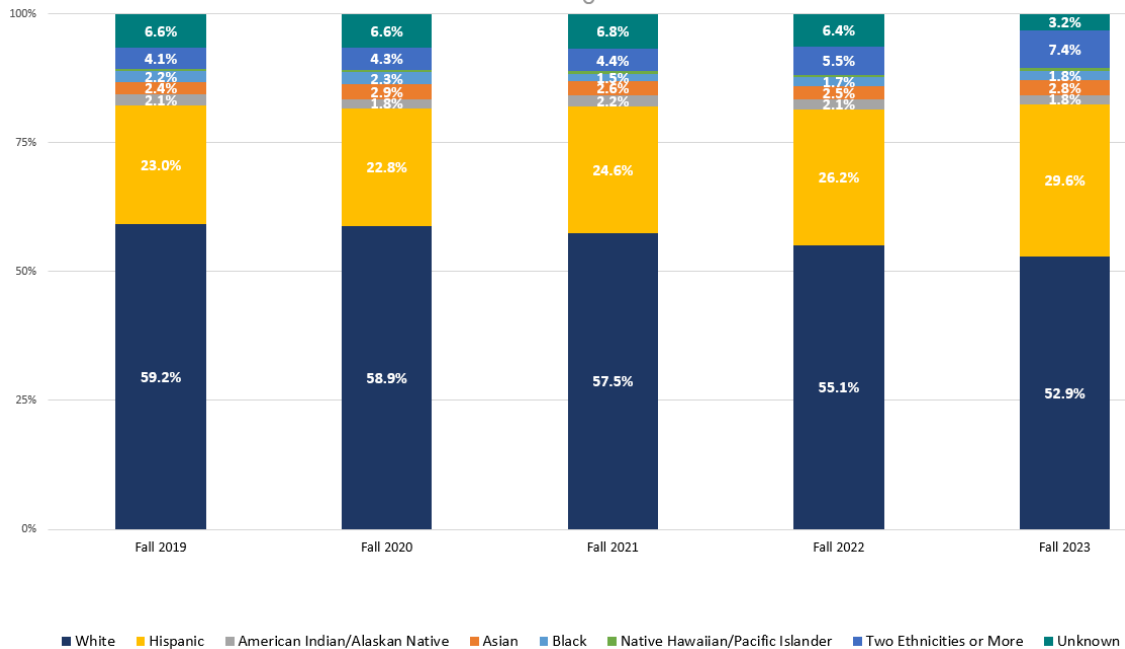

WNC Fall Enrollment Numbers 2019-2023



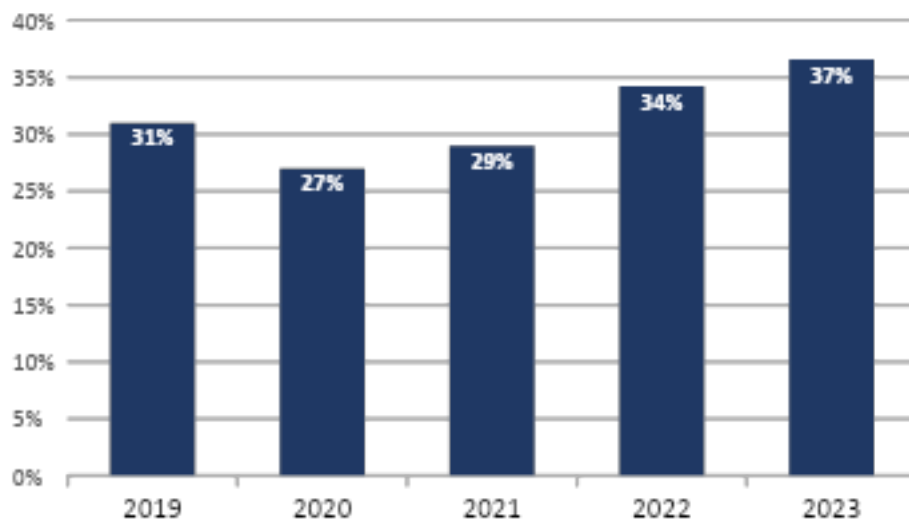

WNC Fall Enrollment Numbers by Race/Ethnicity 2019-2023

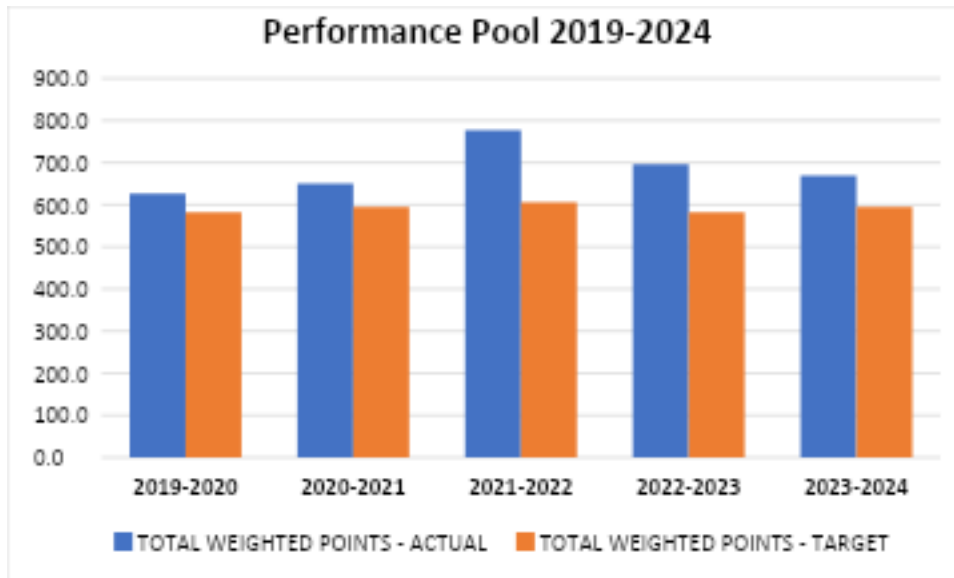

WNC 150% Graduation Rates 2019-2023

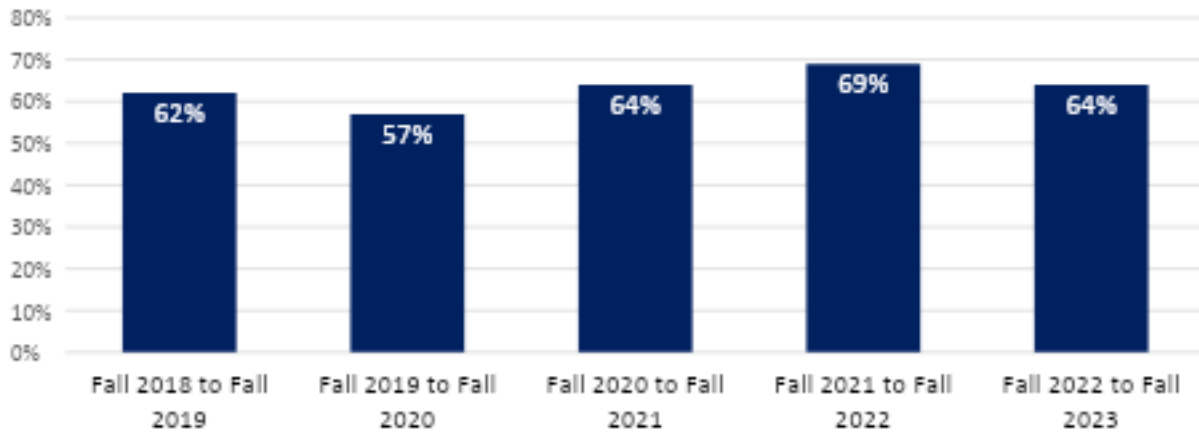

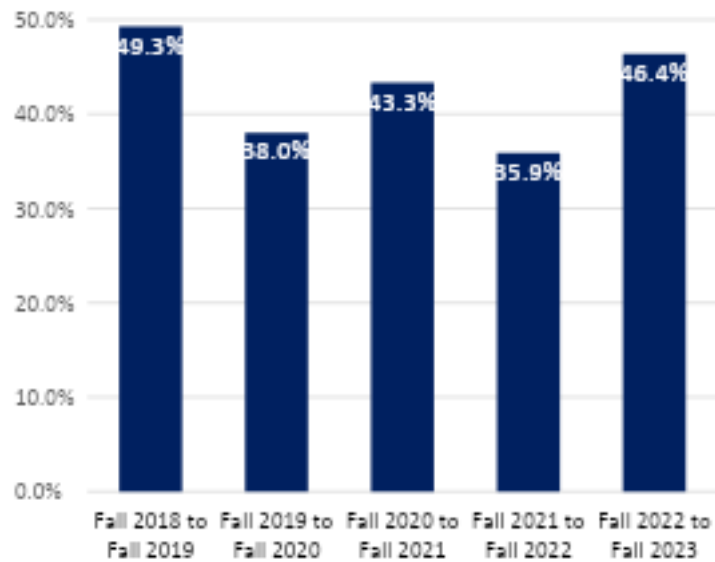

WNC First-Time, Full-Time Fall-to-Fall Retention Rates 2018-2022

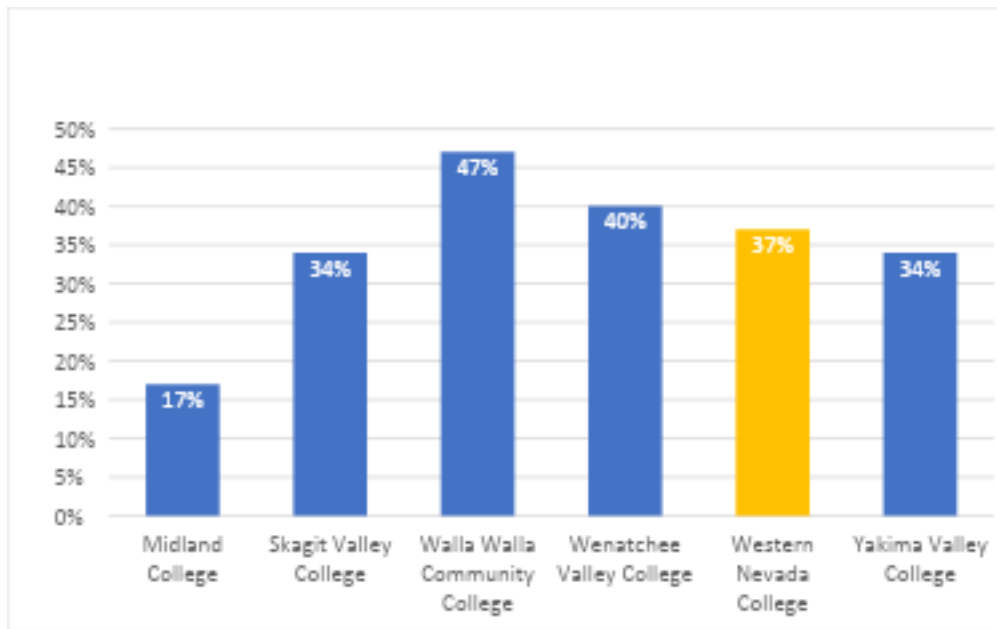

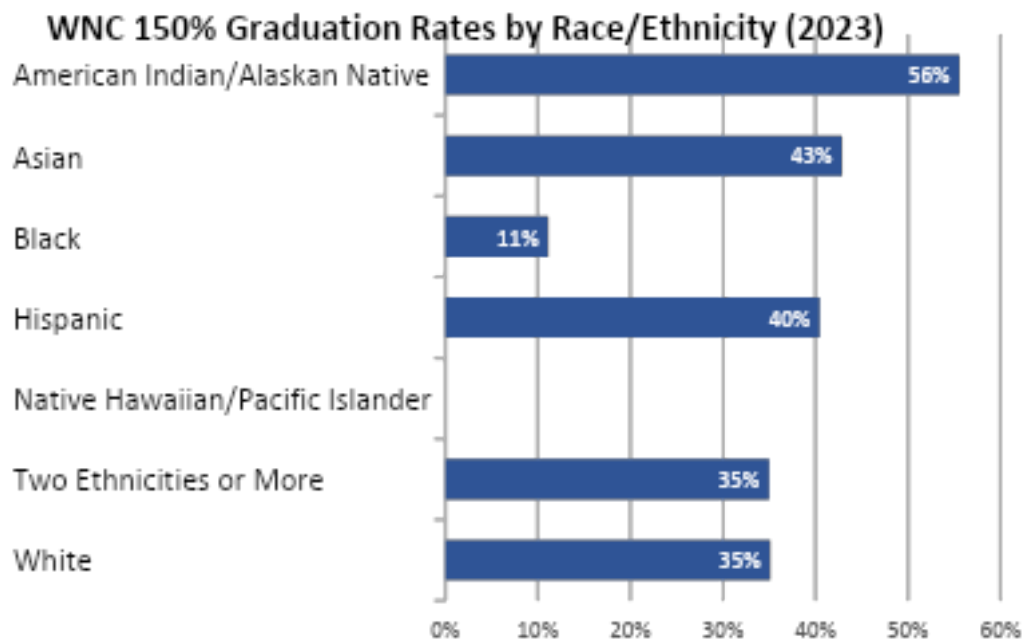
WNC First-Time, Part-Time Fall-to-Fall Retention Rates 2019-2023



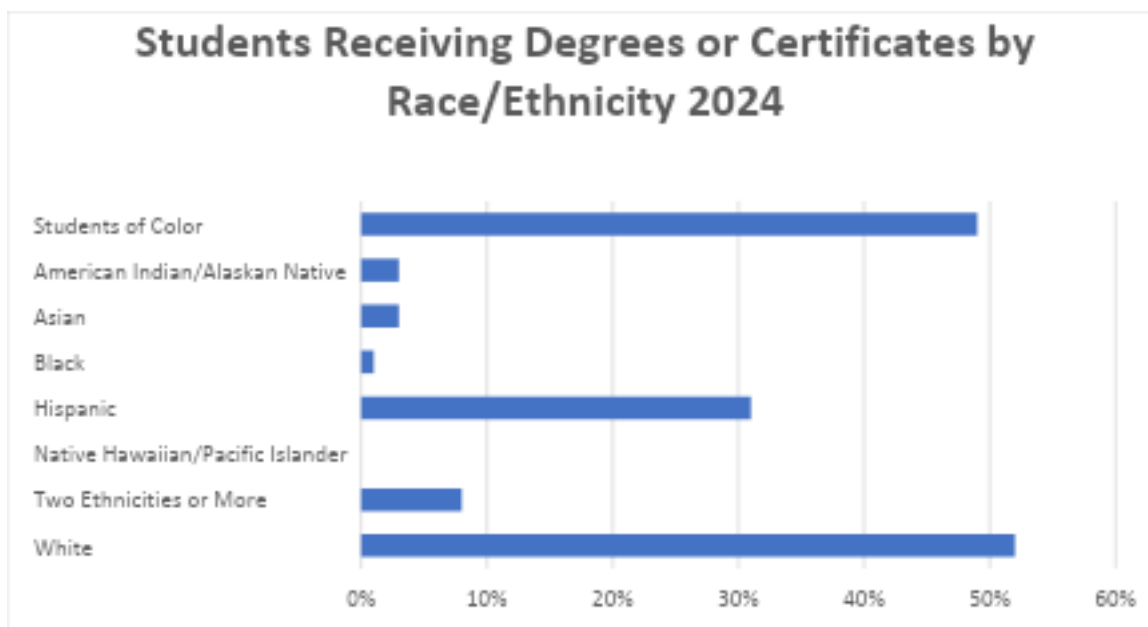
