

WNC College-Level Course Success Rates

In 2021-22, students earned a grade of C- or better (P or S in non-graded classes) in 80% of college-level classes (courses numbered 100 or higher). The data below disaggregate the course success rates by student population and class variables and report the most recent enrollments (duplicated headcounts) for the year, the most recent course success rate, the trends in course success rates for the last five years, and compare those to the overall college-level course success rate (yellow line at 80%) for all students in college-level classes. Final grades are based on end-of-term snapshots and include audits, incompletes and withdrawals. Independent study, field study and clinical Nursing classes are excluded. 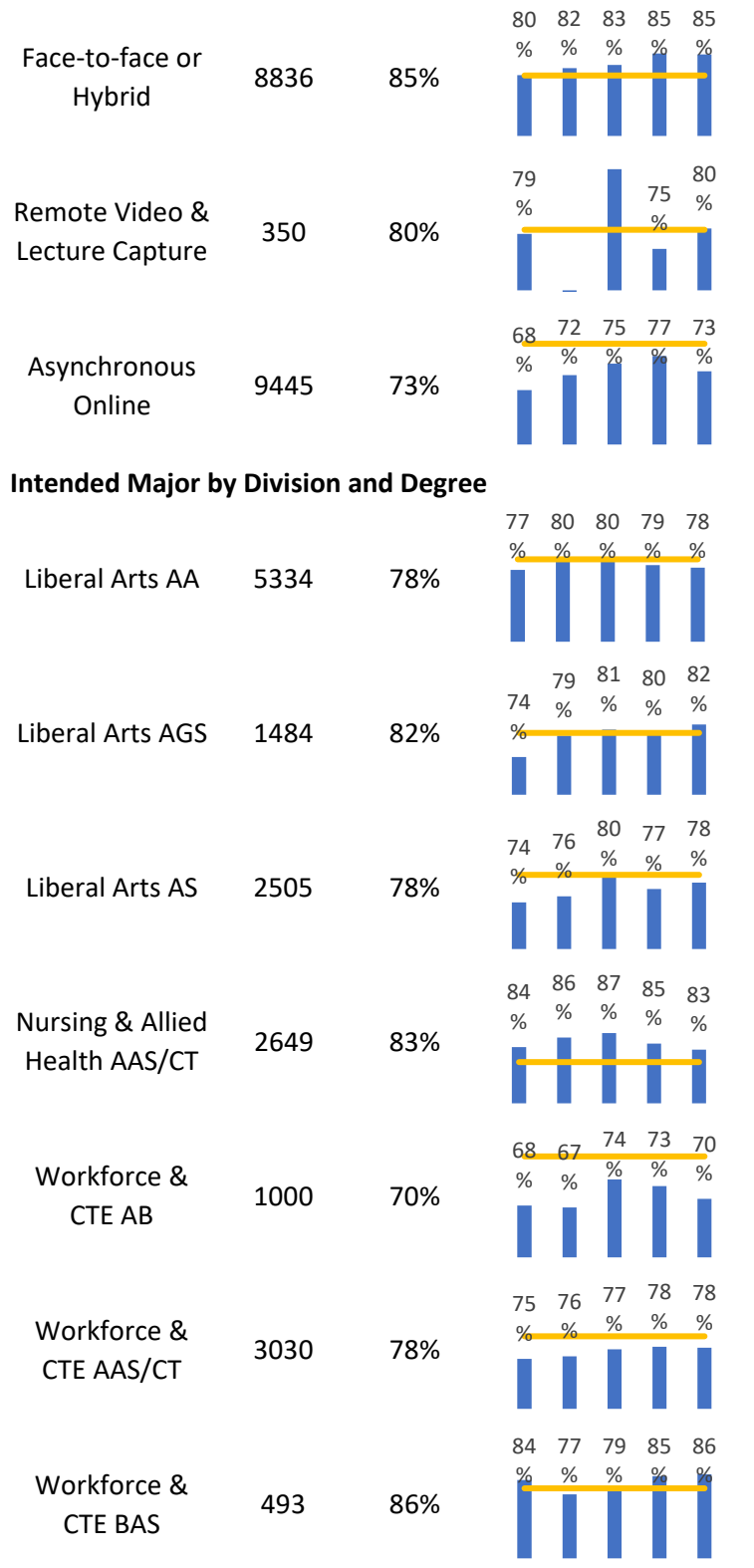

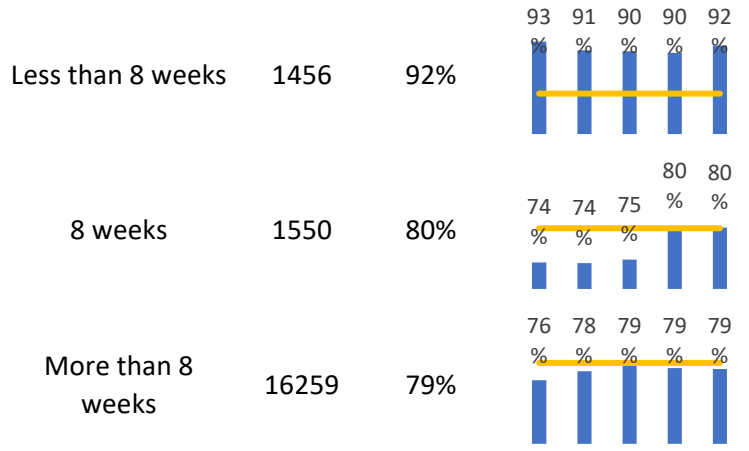

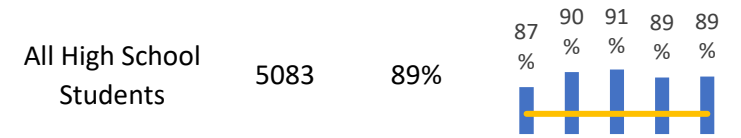

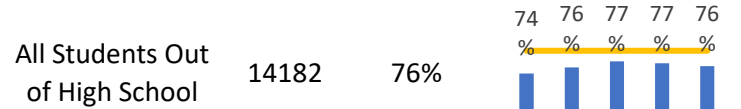
Class Length in Weeks



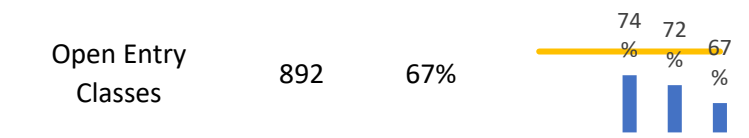
High School Students



Students Out of High School



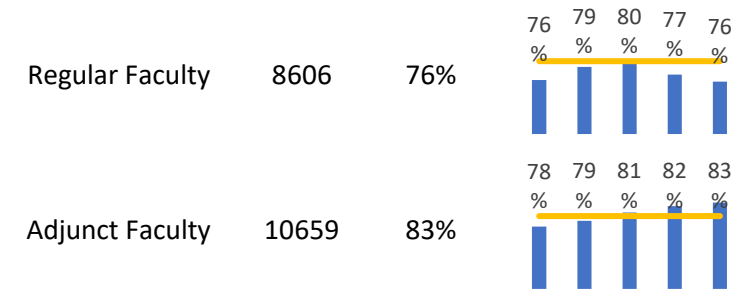

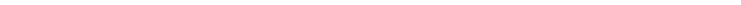

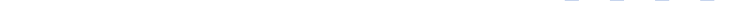
Instructional Faculty Appointment Type



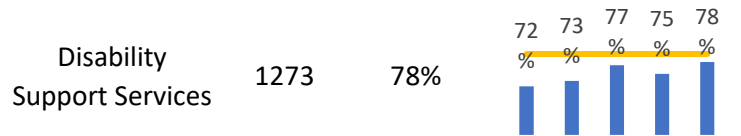
Higher Education in Prison Program



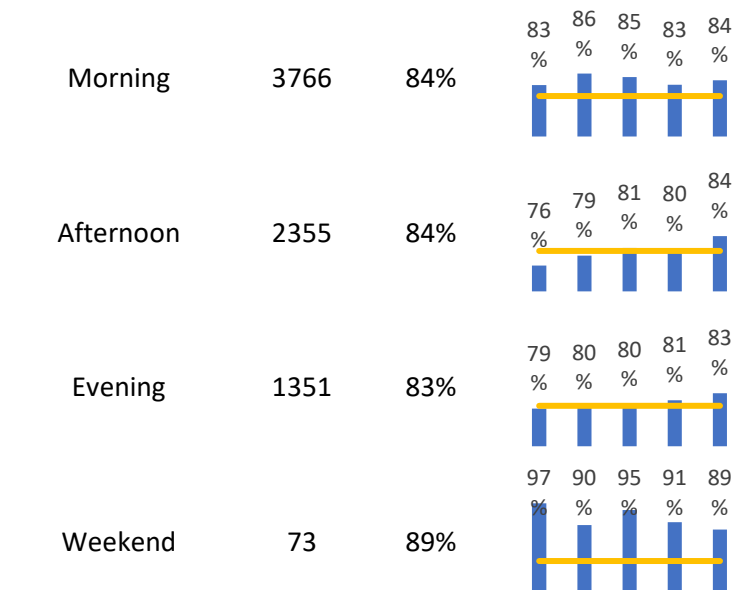

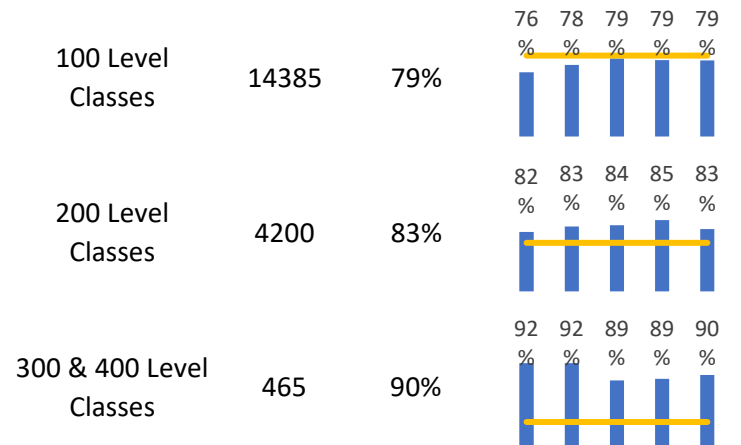
Students Receiving Disability Support Services
