Summary of Discussion	<ul> <li>Open Educational Resources (OER) is a program that provides a textbook or section of a textbook produced without the copyright restrictions.</li> <li>Books with Copyright restrictions cannot be photocopied, modified, or shared.</li> <li>OpenStax, an organization, publishes openly licensed textbooks.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>OER is available digitally for students to have access to textbooks, reducing the cost of textbooks as much as possible.</li> <li>OER at WNC began about two years ago and has seen great success.</li> <li>Faculty has done research:         <ul> <li>35 Faculty users in 52 different topics</li> <li>Saving about \$110 thousand for students, a quarter of a million dollars in savings since the start of the program.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Students do not need to pay much,</li> <li>Books are available on Canvas first day of class.</li> <li>Ron is asking for ASWN to be involved in OER Heroes Campaign             <ul> <li>For faculty/staff who use OER</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
