They are now requesting for the money to go to the Club Account to assist with other expenses they have.</li> <li>While we will not be voting, Heather wanted to inform us on these changes.</li> <li>In the past, clubs have asked for us to fund events or to assist with other expenses.</li> <li>The original request was for \$1,200 which was \$25 a person</li> </ul>
