

WNC gets \$1.46M grant to renovate science labs

The science labs at Western Nevada College will soon get a makeover thanks to a grant from the William N. Pennington Foundation.

"Today we secured a grant for \$1.46 million to renovate the science labs," said Niki Gladys, director of development, Western Nevada College Foundation, during the Leisure Hour Club dinner at the Carson Nugget Casino Hotel Wednesday.

The grant will enable the school to update its facility and double the size of its cadaver lab, among other things.
