

WNC TAACCCT Grant Projects Summary

The Trade Adjustment Assistance Community College and Career Training (TAACCCT) program is funded and administered by the Department of Labor – Employment Training Administration. The goal of this program is to build the capacity of community colleges and allow them to explore non-traditional methods of instruction in order to enhance and accelerate training delivery. The program's target population is TAA eligible, however, the numbers in Nevada are not high. We focused primarily on unemployed and under-employed populations, but also serve traditional students. The Round 4 target population is veterans.
