Comments/Information	Information and Discussion: JW Lazzari:  Requirements  Students need a complete and submitted FAFSA to automatically receive funds  Citizenship  No convictions of drug offenses while using student federal aid. etc.  Completed checklist Satisfactory academic progress The level of enrollment will also impact the funds being rewarded to a student  Jumpstart students will not be rewarded Including exclusive online only scheduled students  Targeting students who were forced to move to online classes and had a disruption or expense due to COVID-19  80% of funds will go to this targeted group of students - \$545,000 The other 20% is for the application process for students that aren't in the targeted group (a complete FAFSA will still be required) DACA students can be eligible to other funds  Gabrielle - further explanation of academic progress requirement/components  JW response: Cumulative GPA is overlooked (need 2.0 or higher)  Students cumulative completion rate (at least 67% completion rate)  Most recent semester completion rate (also 67%) Heather- Update on Fall 2020 funds JW response: No fall 2020 funds Have one year to spend the funds

Comments/Information	Information and Discussion: Kyle Dalpe  Gabrielle - suggests TMCC's online textbook conversion system and will get more information on it Is looking into student's preference of online resources In contract with Follett Donnell - Teachers regarding their book requests or other resources (less costly) outside of WNC's bookstore Kyle's response: Students with a completed FAFSA get aid to pay their books from the bookstore, not necessarily other resources outside WNC Donnell- had complications with his online book order and was forced to seek a third party Heather - Students have had issues with Follett regarding their process to deliver books. The issue is in progress to become resolved Kyle - There are concerns of the August semester on how books will be delivered to students if COVID-19 complications continue Jeffrey Downs joins the meeting at 2:54 P.M Heather - A "Walmart" type pick up may be the best option Kyle - Regarding Dannell's comment about teachers' book requests when there are no actual books available, it's up to the bookstore to pick that up.
